Guidelines:

- Applicants eligible to apply include graduate students at an accredited college or university. It is a requirement that the applicant is pursuing a degree in music.
- The scholarship is intended to assist in the development of choir directors, singers and choir related instrumentalists.
- Recipients of scholarships will be honoured guests at the annual fall Swiss Choir Winzerfest Concert and dance, where the awards will be presented. This event will be held at St. Basil's Cultural Center (10819 - 71 Ave, Edmonton, Alberta) on Saturday, November 14th, 2020 at 5:30 pm.
- A direct link with the ESMC will be established post Winzerfest, in order to continue a mutually beneficial relationship with the recipient and the choir. This may include participation in a choir rehearsal, performance or other opportunities for collaboration. ESMC encourages recipients of scholarships to notify the choir of any local concerts they are involved with, and communication of these events will be shared with the ESMC membership.
- Scholarship selection will be administered by the EMSC Scholarship Committee
- AWARD: \$1500 award per recipient
- Application Deadline: ***April 22nd, 2020***
